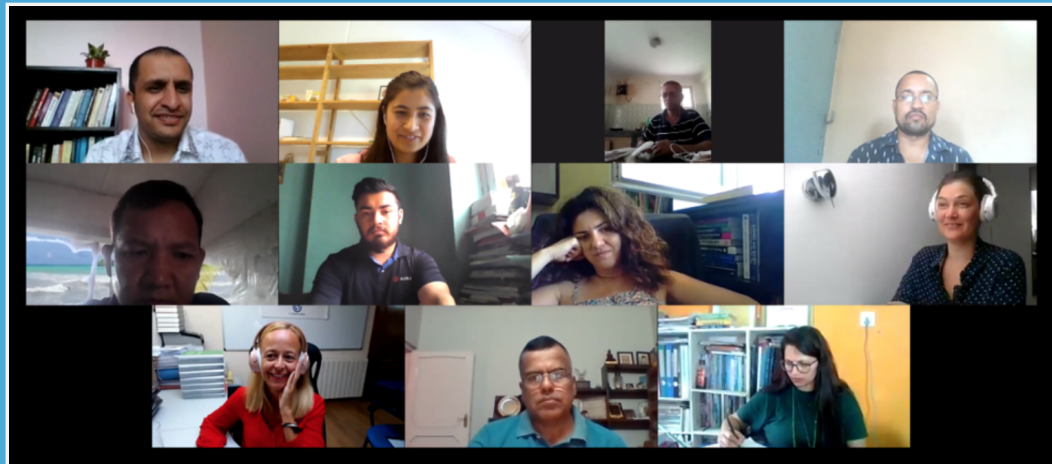



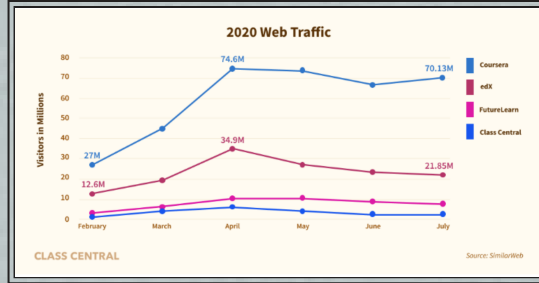
From talk to walk: Path2Integrity contributed to a recent research


